

SBI Student Mentorship Program 「師友導向計劃」 (2008-2009)

The Program

The SBI Student Mentorship Program is organized by the VTC School of Business and Information Systems (SBI) starting in Sept 2006 to complement students' academic life with a taste of 'real' business practices and protocols.

Program Objectives

It aims at providing mentees (graduating students) with an additional avenue of learning by tapping the vast professional experience offered by the mentors while the mentees are still studying.

Program Description

- (a) Distinguished professionals are invited as mentors.

- (b) Mentees are assigned to the mentors by a matching process and they can get to know each other at the opening ceremony to be held around end of November 2008.

- (b) Upon mutual agreement, mentees can interact with mentors via e-mail, fax, telephone or on face-to-face basis.

- (c) Mentees are expected to initiate interactions with the mentors and prepare interaction records after the meeting. These records will be regarded as indicative progress reports of the mentor-mentee relationship. At the closing ceremony, tentatively scheduled in May 2009, the following awards shall be presented:
 - (i) Mentors: Certificates of Appreciation
 - (ii) Mentees who have completed the program: Certificates of Participation
 - (iii) Best Mentor–Mentee Teams for outstanding enriching interactions: Best Practice Awards
